Subject: Vancomycin ranges, ordering and reporting

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The new therapeutic ranges for Vancomycin, effective immediately, will be 15-20 mg/L and greater than 25 mg/L being a critical or toxic level at which the ordering physician will receive a notification.

New guidelines by the Infectious Disease Society of America (IDSA) do not recommend monitoring Vancomycin peaks. Also, IDSA guidelines recommend that the only time a random Vancomycin level be performed is on a patient undergoing dialysis. The new guidelines also recommend a trough level to be drawn immediately before the fifth dose.
