



EXPOSURE PROTOCOL

A Quick Reference Guide.

Exposure is an unfortunate exchange of blood or body fluid between the "Source" and the "Recipient" by needle stick or other means. The "**Source**" is the person from whom the blood or body fluid came. The "**Recipient**" is the person who was exposed to the fluid from the source.
