SUBJECT: Update - Urine Culture Reporting

Regional Medical Laboratory has conducted an internal study to investigate how often urine cultures that are reported as *no growth* at 24 hours of incubation, were then reported as positive at 48 hours. It was determined that only 2-3% of cultures in this group showed clinically significant changes with the additional 24 hours of incubation.

As a result of this study, **C URINE RT** and **C URI FLX** orders will receive a final report at 24 hours if the culture is *no growth*. These finaled cultures will continue to be held for an additional 24 hours in order to identify rare slow growing pathogens. Should these pathogens appear, an amended report will be issued and will be called to the ordering physician. All positive cultures will continue to be finaled at 48 hours.
