SUBJECT: Update - Blood Culture Reporting

Starting May 29, 2013, Regional Medical Laboratory will be updating our reporting procedure for blood cultures. Negative blood cultures will receive a preliminary report at 24 hours and a <u>final report at 4 days</u>. Cultures will continue to be monitored by BD Bactec instruments for 1 additional day, resulting in a full 5 day incubation period. The small percentage of cultures that turn positive after 4 days will receive an amended report and will be called to the ordering physician.

This decision is based upon the results of an internal study which showed only 2% of all positive cultures occur after 4 days of incubation. Additionally, the majority of these would clinically be considered as skin contaminants.
