SUBJECT: Interpretation of results for the **Antibody to the Hepatitis B surface antigen**.

Test name: **HEP AB BS** CPT Code: 86706

Regional Medical Laboratory has been notified by Siemens, vendor for immunoassays, that there has been a performance update for the detection of the Antibody to the Hepatitis B surface antigen.

This update has changed the reporting criteria from the standard index value to a measure value. The accepted criteria for immunity to Hepatitis B virus (HBV) is a value of anti-HBV surface antigen (HBs) activity >/= 10 mIU/ml as defined by the WHO International Reference Preparation.

Currently RML reports: Non-Reactive index value <1.00

Reactive index value ≥ 1.00

New reporting values: Non-Reactive <10 mIU/ml

Reactive >10 mIU/ml
