SUBJECT:	Fecal Fat Quantitative Test Changes

Effective September 21, 2015, there will be a change in the test ordering names and collect kits used for Fecal Fat Quantitative testing. Results from this assay may be useful in monitoring patients on exogenous enzyme therapy for chronic diarrhea or diagnosing patients whose stool contains excessive fat for malabsorbtion or maldigestion.

Specimen volume and processing for this test is as follows:

- Patient may collect 24-hour, 48-hour, or 72-hour fecal specimen in an ARUP Stool Collection Container.
- Testing for random specimens will no longer be available.
- Specimen must be kept refrigerated during the collection process.
- The specimen container must be marked with the appropriate duration for the specimen that is to be collected.
- Once collection is complete, please freeze the specimen as soon as possible.
- The specimen stability is as follows: room temp, one (1) hour; refrigerated, four (4) days; frozen, two (2) weeks.
- Please submit separate stool specimens if electrolyte or osmolality tests are also required.

The RML test code number 35-00990 will be discontinued and replace with three (3) possible test codes. Please choose the appropriate test code listed below for the duration of the stool collection. The new tests will be performed by Nuclear Magnetic Resonance Spectroscopy. The reference range will change from <7g/24h to 0.0-2.0g/24h for children and 0.0-6.0g/24h for adults. CPT codes will remain the same. Please contact your sales representative for current pricing for these tests.
