SUBJECT: Collection of Mumps Specimens For Evaluation By a Molecular Method (PCR)

With the recent increase in confirmed Mumps cases throughout the country, Regional Medical Laboratory Inc. would like to remind our clients of the suggested testing option for diagnosis of Mumps. A molecular test method (PCR) is preferred over viral culture as it can rapidly detect RNA from the Mumps virus in infected individuals. PCR is an effective tool to assist in the diagnosis of Mumps in both vaccinated and unvaccinated individuals, particularly in situations of disease outbreaks.
