RML is pleased to announce the following updates to our thyroglobulin test offerings effective 9/5/2017:

While routine measurement of serum Thyroglobulin (Tg) for initial evaluation of thyroid nodules is not recommended by the American Thyroid Association, tandem serial measurement of Tg and Thyroglobulin Autoantibody (anti-Tg Ab) plays an important role in risk stratification and longitudinal monitoring of patients with differentiated thyroid cancer. Anti-Tg Ab occur in approximately 25% of thyroid cancer patients and can falsely decrease Tg measured by Immunoassay. In the presence of anti-Tg Ab, an accurate measurement of Tg may be obtained by Liquid Chromatography Tandem Mass Spectrometry.

Therefore, RML will replace Thyroglobulin (TC#3608030) with a Thyroglobulin Panel (TC# 3612483), which includes both Tg and anti-Tg Ab by Immunoassay. RML will also offer a Thyroglobulin Analyzer (TC# 3612485), which will reflex a Thyroglobulin by Immunoassay on anti-Tg Ab-negative serum or a Thyroglobulin by Liquid Chromatography Tandem Mass Spectrometry on anti-Tg Ab-positive serum. Frozen or refrigerated serum will remain the appropriate specimen type for Thyroglobulin studies.
