Subject: Cardiolipin IgM and IgG Antibody Reference Range Changes

On 3/26/2018, Regional Medical Laboratory went live with new technology for fully automated, random access chemiluminescent autoimmune testing. This new technology brings workflow efficiencies and improved assay performance compared with existing enzyme-based technology.

As part of this change, the reference range for Cardiolipin IgM and IgG Antibodies and Beta-2 Glycoprotein IgM and IgG Antibodies were modified. Please take note of the new reference ranges in the table below. The unit of measure, which is an arbitrary assignment, has also changed to CU (chemiluminescent units). Whether Cardiolipin IgG and IgM Antibodies and Beta-2 Glycoprotein IgM and IgG Antibodies are ordered singularly, as part of a group test or as part of the Lupus Anticoagulant Analyzer, the updated ranges listed will apply.

Patient results with a numeric value < 20.0 CU will be reported as <20.0 CU. Numeric results of 20.0 or greater will be reported as discrete numerical values.
