Subject:	Kappa and Lambda Light Chain Testing		

As part of Regional Medical Laboratory's and Pathology Laboratory Associates' ongoing efforts to ensure laboratory test offerings are in keeping with best practices, we are pleased to announce upcoming changes to our Kappa and Lambda Light Chain test offerings.

Analysis of free kappa and free lambda light chains plays a vital role in the diagnosis, prognosis and ongoing monitoring of patients with a monoclonal gammopathy. It is recommended that free light chain results be interpreted in correlation with the clinical presentation of the patient and alongside serum protein electrophoresis and/or immunofixation results. To continue to provide comprehensive yet flexible testing options to our clients, RML has added a new stand-alone test for kappa and lambda light chains that does not include a separate pathology interpretation.

RML will continue to offer Serum Protein Electrophoresis Analyzer testing for comprehensive review when appropriate as well as stand-alone protein electrophoresis, immunofixation and free light chain test orders for a la carte ordering, if preferred.
