SUBJECT: West Nile Virus Testing Change in Methodology

The sole source of West Nile Virus indirect fluorescent antibody (IFA) slides is no longer producing slides. It is necessary for Regional Medical Laboratory to convert to an enzyme-linked immunosorbent assay (EIA) which is produced by Focus Diagnostics, a pioneer in West Nile Virus testing. The new method provides same sensitivity and specificity as the IFA method.

The conversion to the EIA technology will be effective August 25, 2008.

Specimen Type: Tiger/gold clot tube

Testing Schedule: Our new testing schedule will be Tuesdays and Thursdays on first shift. Confirmations for WNV IGM will be performed on Wednesdays and Fridays.

Specimen Storage: Specimen is good refrigerated for 48 hours. If testing will be delayed longer than 48 hours, specimen should be centrifuged, serum separated and frozen.
