## 2008 CPT4 Code Changes for AMA

The American Medical Association (AMA) CPT code changes for 2008 will become effective on January 1, 2008. Regional Medical Laboratory will implement the following changes in CPT4 codes to comply with changes suggested by the AMA. The table below lists the code changes that might affect you.

Please note that the code 86586 (Unlisted antigen, each), previously used for some skin tests as well as some flow cytometry tests, is being deleted and will be replaced by two more specific codes.

- 86486 for the skin tests
- 86356 for mononuclear cell antigen, quantitative, (e.g., flow cytometry), not otherwise specified.
