Subject: National STI collection devices shortages

Due to ongoing national shortages of testing supplies due to the COVID pandemic, the following collection supplies for sexually transmitted infection (STI) testing are currently unavailable:

APTIMA Urine Transport Tube APTIMA Unisex Swab Collection kit

The vendor has indicated that APTIMA Urine Transport Tubes are expected to be available for shipment the week of 09/03/2020.

APTIMA Multitest Swabs are still available, and can be used for all STI swab testing. This is the recommended alternative for the APTIMA Unisex Swab Collection kit until supplies are replenished.
